IN ALL LOVE AND SERVE

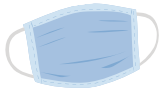
Protecting the health, safety, and well-being of every member of the Loyola community is our highest priority. This year we will be doing 100% in-person instruction. Virtual Learning will not be offered. Any positive results of COVID-19 will be handled in a case-by-case manner.

ON-CAMPUS PROTOCOLS



TEMPERATURE CHECKS

Student's temperature will be taken daily prior to entry. Students with flu-like symptoms will not be allowed entry. Students exhibiting symptoms during the day will be isolated immediately and must be picked up. Students cannot be returned to school without clearance from their Physician showing a negative COVID-19 test result.



FACIAL COVERINGS

Students/staff will be required to wear masks as part of our protocol.



HAND WASHING

Frequent handwashing will be in effect and hand sanitizer will be available inside every classroom and hallways.



CLEANING AND SANITIZING

The School will adhere to a comprehensive cleaning plan. We will create a disinfection protocol for cleaning doorknobs, counters, and other high touch areas. The School will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected each evening.



NO SHARING POLICY

All students will have their own personal school supplies. Students will not be allowed to share toys, materials, books, etc.



VISITORS

With limited exceptions, parents and visitors will not be permitted in school building unless they request an appointment. Parents and visitors are required to wear a mask to come into the school.



TRAVEL

Any student who is traveling outside of Miami will be required to stay at home for 72 hours. After 72 hours after your arrival you can conduct a PCR test and once the test result has been received the student can reincorporate in school.



AFTER CARE

After care will be provided, only to families that have registered with anticipation. Day by day aftercare will not be permitted.



STAY AT HOME

If a student, or any of their household family member develops symptoms and/or tests positive for COVID-19, please inform us immediately. Decisions about classroom closures will be determined on a case-by-case basis.



LUNCH AND SNACKS

School catering and Food Program will be served in disposable containers. Hot foods should be brought in a thermos. Food delivery must be dropped off with the child's name by 11:00 a.m. Drinking fountains will not be operational, students should bring their own water bottles every day to school. *Lunch must be healthy and balanced.*
